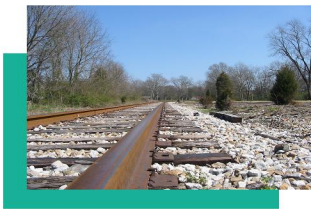

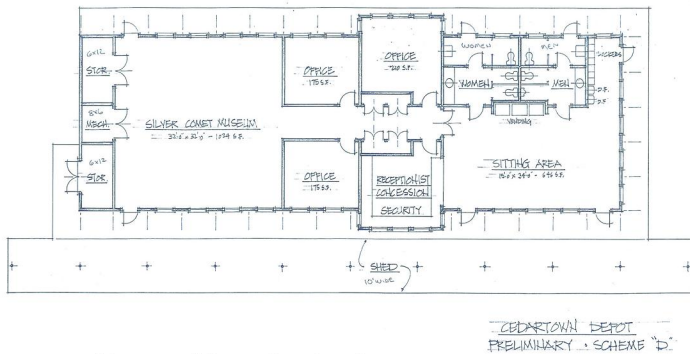

Rail stations are a rapidly shrinking resource for communities, disappearing at an alarming rate each decade. Bron Cleveland Associates has helped communities such as Cedartown restore and/or rebuild their depots. Our interests are not only in historic rehabilitation, but in recreating the feel of the old depot for currently viable uses with modern amenities.

Historic Rehabilitation

The depot was rebuilt in keeping with the original depot and became home to: a Georgia welcome center, the Polk County Chamber of Commerce, the Silver Comet Museum and Trail Head and the Cedartown Main Street Program office. The chosen location connects PATH's "Silver Comet" bicycle/pedestrian trail, the CSX Railroad, downtown's nationally listed historic district and US Highway 27 (Main Street).

The site of the former rail passenger depot will be the home of a new multi-use facility that will be the "crown jewel" of the Main Street streetscape program. The enhancements will include courtyards, landscaping, and interpretive displays.
