The purpose of this project was to prepare a concept plan for a 13 acre reforestation area and a 1.3 mile greenway along the Chattahoochee River connecting two units of the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area.



An application prepared by BCA was submitted by the City of Duluth to the Georgia Forestry Commission's Urban and Community Forestry (U&CF) Grant Assistance program and funding was approved.



GREENSPACE PRESERVATION

Project management by BCA included preparation of the concept plan, holding community participation workshops, coordination of federal and state agencies to assist in environmental data analysis, and the preparation of grant applications for future funding. BCA also was responsible for budget analysis, base data inventory, and the preparation of illustrative drawings and other presentation materials for various meetings throughout the planning process.
