Livable Center Initiative (LCI) grant funds administered by the Atlanta Regional Commission are used to create pedestrian and bicycle connections to (and within) activity centers. In Duluth, the creation of a new "town green" where people can congregate is being enhanced by LCI projects that will provide critical connections to the green and to other downtown amenities. The projects, also, will encourage more dense, mixed-use redevelopment.



Most of the enhancements will be placed in the existing rights-of-way and will connect to Duluth's center, the new "town green," shown above, being built by the City of Duluth.

LIVABLE CENTERS INITIATIVE

This project will involve many infrastructure improvements such as sidewalks, crosswalks, ADA compliant ramps and traffic calming devices (e.g., bump-outs). It also will incorporate new street furniture, decorative fencing and lighting, landscaping with trees and flowerbeds, decorative street signage and other streetscape amenities which will enhance both the aesthetics and the safety of the downtown area.
